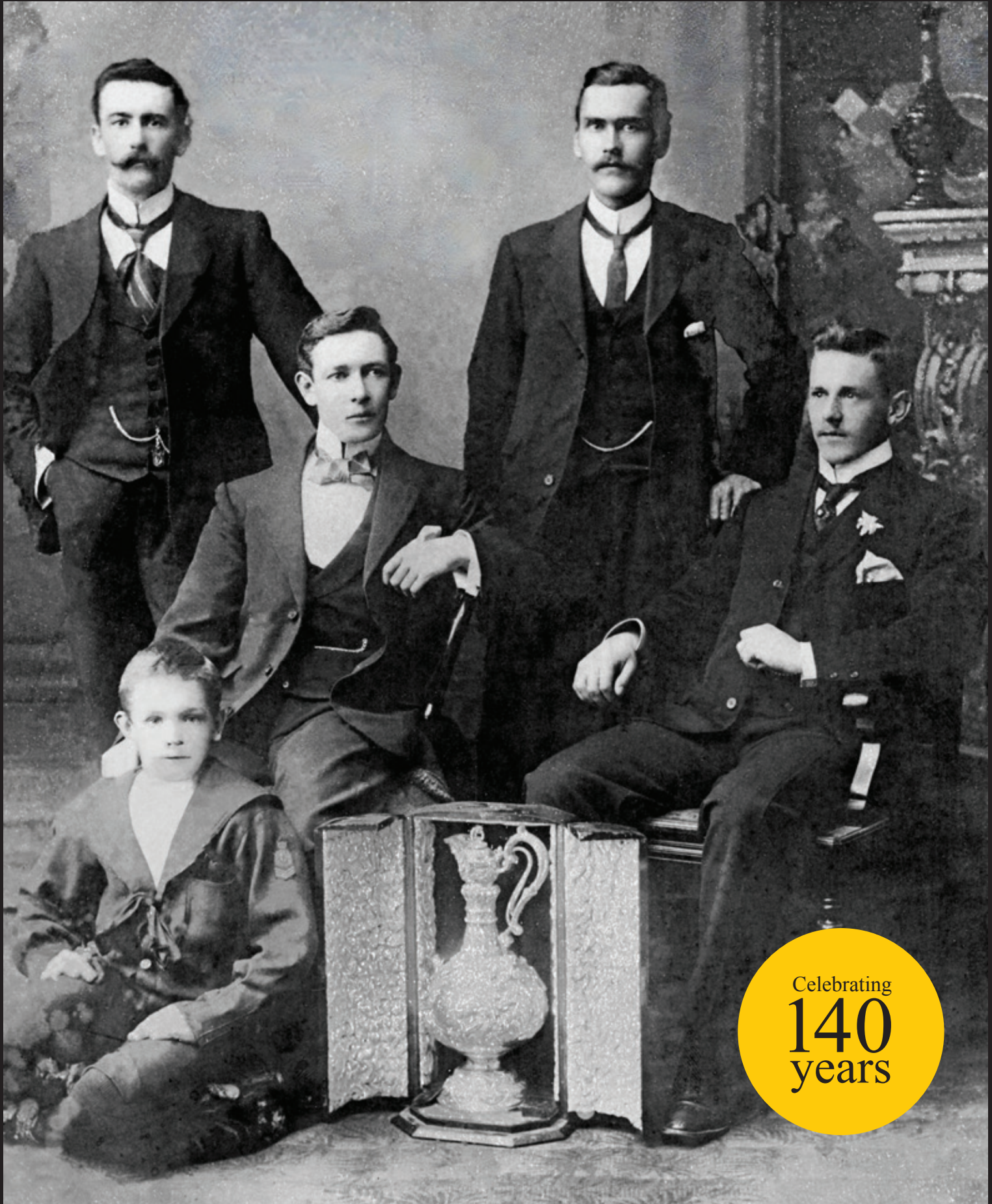

The club shutdown has represented both challenges and opportunities for the club. Challenges because we have had to rely on our sister clubs for access to the water and opportunities because in this space new friendships have been made. I would like to thank our friends at Leichhardt RC, St Joseph's College, Drummoyne RC, Glebe RC, Sydney Women's RC and Macquarie Uni RC for their fellowship and understanding.

As an extension of the shutdown group of mainly Para rowers have relocated to premises at Macquarie Uni RC and have taken this opportunity to register as a separate rowing organisation. Whilst we are sad to see them leave we can only wish them well in their new endeavour.

The club finances are now reliant on membership renewals and funding payments. I would like to express appreciation to Mark Thompson for maintaining the accounts and providing information that has allowed the committee to make decisions.

In this year the club needs to acknowledge the work of our two captains Jeremy Child and Freya Warner van Dijk for the running of boats and crews at regattas. Keeping our squads engaged has been important work so I'd like to thank and acknowledge our squad leaders and indeed every member in every squad who has helped with keeping everyone communicating and even on the water when circumstances permitted.

Fundraising events this year have been entirely on raising the extra funds needed for the building renovation. I would like to thank all those that have contributed via direct donation, forward paying membership, hall hire. In this space I would like to thank the efforts of our long serving club secretary Maria O'Connor for her ongoing work with management at the club.

We are nowhere without our team of volunteers. Top of the list this year was the big pack up, I would like to thank the efforts of all of the members and particularly Joe Theonnes, Zoe Morrison, Beverly Malone for their assistance in organising the decant of the club to allow the building work to commence.

I'd like to thank the committee for all their support and advice in what is such a significant phase of club evolution. Members will be pleased to know they had a strong and diverse group providing expertise and assistance to me along what had been a challenging path of Covid and club restoration.

To close I would like to say that we need not only to renew the building but also renew the vision for the club going forward. After being on life support for the last 20 years the wider challenge for the coming year is to re-establish rowing Balmain as the Premier Rowing club on the shores of the Iron Cove.

I'm sure we'll all be excited for this moment. I'm sure the boats will appreciate the 1.5m additional headroom downstairs so they can be shouldered safely without crashing into the exit signs!

Treasurer's Report

Another disruptive year. A large profit. A large grant. Big changes at BRC. This is not a normal year for BRC's finances.

That BRC made a profit might surprise everyone (again) as we lived through COVID and lost hall hire income, learn-to-row income and the closed shed.

The club's balance sheet remains strong with net assets of \$1,329,921 — up significantly from \$1,052,696 in 2021 and expect this to increase as the club gets more grant money to transform the shed.

The club's audited net profit was \$277,224 (\$10,135 in 2021). The large profit increase is solely due to grant money of \$300,000 coming from the NSW Office of Sport - Greater Cities Sports Fund. A further \$700,000 is expected in the coming year. Without this grant money the club would have made a loss in a disruptive year due to the club's usual reliance on income other than membership.

Our cash position increased (as at 31 March 2022) to \$414,689 (\$256,685 in 2021) again due to the grant money not being spent as at 31 March 2022.

So whilst BRC has a strong balance sheet, has made a profit and has increased its cash position, it will spend the money on the shed construction works.

I confirm that the club has no borrowings and negligible liabilities. The trailer, clubhouse, fleet and fixtures and fittings are fully insured

Rowing income

The club normally relies on income over and above membership renewals. The club's expenses for this year were \$110,970 but its membership income was \$64,487 (down from 2021) due to limited income from learn-to-row activities.

\$9,991 (2022)

No hall hire income will be taken until the shed has re-opened. As stated every year, this much needed income is normally the club's most regular and consistent 'other' income.

Grants and Donations - \$300,095

Sponsorship - Nil

Fundraising - \$1,964

Where does the money go?

Depreciation expense — \$39,340 — accounting treatment of a non-cash item. The club depreciates the following items according to accounting principles: clubhouse, property improvements, club equipment and fleet and equipment.

Coaching expenses \$6,537 was \$36,665.

Insurance - \$23,601 — for shed, club equipment, fleet and equipment and the trailer.

Who does the work?

Your seat fees - Marie-Laure Aymonier runs the seat fee account which is a difficult job. Thanks so much ML.

Your membership - Maria O'Connor, BRC Secretary who runs Revolutionise, our membership software system.

Your Committee - finance accountability and governance lies with the Committee, that is, accounts payable, accounts receivable, banking, BAS lodgement, Xero reconciliations, cash flow, grant applications, insurance, Australian Sports Foundation funding, end-of-year financial statements, audit and behind the scenes working for the benefit of BRC.

Architecture/Building/Legal/Contracting - Your club is incredibly lucky to have Joe Grech, an Architect, Jeremy Child a Lawyer, Richard Armitage a Senior Development Manager and Matthew Braithwaite-Young who runs a Marketing Consultancy. Without their free services, the club rejuvenation would not be financially viable. The project is not a simple one and has not been without hiccups and I want to acknowledge their tireless work and some sleepless nights. All members owe them a debt.

Post 31 March 2022 significant matters:

The club has received further grant moneys from OOS for an amount of \$500,000 in August 2022 and is expecting another \$200,000 when the clubhouse rejuvenation is closer to completion. The budget for the rejuvenation is \$1,334,000 and your committee is watching carefully during a time of increased construction and materials costs.

As a result of anticipated cost over-run concerns, BRC ran a fundraising drive for members to:

1. Donate tax deductible funds through the Australian Sports Foundation
2. Pre-pay membership at significant discounts
3. Pre-pay hall hire at significant discounts

So far BRC has raised approximately \$70,000 so thank-you to generous members.

The clubhouse rejuvenation is having and will continue to have a significant impact on BRC.

Building Report

The redoubling of efforts toward landing a sizable grant to undertake Good news is that we are finally building after twenty years of remedial works and start/stop small projects and yes we are in for the big ride.

Completed is the installation of 36 new piers under the club to provide a new solid foundation, needless to say that upon opening up a multitude of sins was revealed and the urgent need for renewal was shown the light of day. The whole of the boatshed floor structure has been renewed and raised to its new level 400mm higher than what it was this is to allow for increased sea level. That structural platform was then used to lift the upper floor 1500mm which corrected a fault in the design of the original shed going back to even before BRC was at the site namely the lack of headroom inside the boatshed. We are confident that this big move will be a huge bonus for the club in that it allows 30% more storage space within the same footprint. I would sincerely like to thank our building lifters McDonald Contracting (with the assistance of Romano Constructions) for overcoming the many challenges that presented and their dedication and professionalism to achieve this most critical and difficult task

Now that the lift has been completed the structure re support works are underway under the guidance of our building contractor Richard Romano. Carpenters have been busy renewing the floor supporting system as well as extending the old wall structure downward to meet the new capwales. Steel has been fabricated to be installed to cope with transferring the loads from the upper floors down into the foundations..

Upstairs the big news is that the windows facing the Iron Cove have magically reappeared, The bathrooms have also survived the lift (miracle) and the stripped out Hall is a bigger volume than anyone thought. We also have new 63sq.m. entry deck connecting us back to the park that will also facilitate easy disabled access.

I would like to thank the efforts and patience of the members, the committee and the building committee. There are significant works yet to complete but we are confident that we have the right team and the right relationships to complete the work.

Archive Report

In June 2022 Balmain Rowing club officially celebrated its 140th year of existence with a function held at Dick's Hotel. It was within the walls of this old hotel where BRC pioneers met on 7th June 1882 with the vision of forming a rowing club in the district of Balmain.

To pay tribute to our club and pioneers, during the evening guest were taken on a journey back in time to revisit toasts of bye-gone years, traditionally proposed at BRC events. Some of the toasts were of their time, but were certainly worthy of taking out of the archives on this occasion and given an airing to help capture the long historic life of a humble rowing club in Balmain. Guest were encouraged to follow the old tradition with having their voices heard to the echoes when raising their glasses.

Some of the toasts proposed were -

To the Queen - 140 years ago BRC members raised their glasses to Queen Victoria. Two Kings on and 140years later, we raise our glasses to Queen Victoria's great granddaughter Queen Elizabeth II.

To Our Flag - It seems fitting that we toast our Club's flag. The Balmain Rowing Club flag was designed with in weeks of the club being formed in 1882. The specifications for its design, which are written in the first minute book, are - black and yellow, with a black diamond in the centre bearing the initials BRC. 140 years on the design has remained the same.

To the Press - It is with deep gratitude that I propose a toast to the Press of the yesteryear. For about the first 50 years of our existence the press wrote insightful articles on the formation, growth & success of The Balmain Rowing club. They beautifully captured and documented our history preserving it for generations to come.

To Our Soldier Oarsmen - Over the course of BRC's history it is recorded that we farewelled our oarsmen who fought in the Boer war, WW1, WW2, Korean, Vietnam.

Other traditional toast proposed were to Kindred Clubs, the Ladies, BRC Pioneers and to the mighty Balmain Rowing Club!

It was wonderful to see a contingent of our Life Members attend - Melissa Marzulli, Terry Maher, David Longhurst, Joe Grech, Mathew Braithwaite-Young and Allen Turner. There was also a gathering of our old Oarsmen - John Hansen, Jim Lucas, Brian Guthrie - many great rowing yarns were relived throughout the evening!

Lynette Skelton is known for her long standing commitment to BRC and as one of our first active female oarswomen. Lynette was the leading force behind the original Balmain Women's Rowing club who eventually merged with the Balmain Rowing club in the early 1980's.

Lynette was a successful oarswoman winning many titles including the Australian Championships in the Women's Elite Double Sculls with Elaine Guterres in 1977 and NSW Championships in a single scull in 2008 and 2009.

Lynette Skelton is written into BRC's history as being the first woman in 100 years to be elected onto the Club's committee.

BRC has acknowledged her commitment to the club by naming a boat in her honour. We are also proud to present The Lynette "Skelo" Skelton perpetual trophy awarded to the most competitive BRC master rower each year.

Lynette is retired now and living in an aged care facility in Auckland, New Zealand. We were told by her carer

"I have hung in her room some of her 400 and so medals of which she is so justifiably proud".
